





WP-707 Bald Eagle by OTB Patterns.

There are many ways to complete this project. Following are a few ideas to get you started.

- 1. Start with 2 pieces of material at least 10" square.
- 2. Remove everything marked "R." Note: You will end up with one piece to glue to the second (back) board. Leave square, or cut on circular dashed line. Hole placement provided for attaching chain, or screw placement. Ignore if attaching metal hanger on back.
- 3. Finish the back board, and the eagle with contrasting stains, or paint as desired.

Another way to do this is to:

- 1. Start with 1 or 2 pieces of material at least 10" square.
- 2. Carefully cut all pieces out marked "R."
- 3. Stain all "R" items with a light stain, and the eagle with a darker stain, or paint as desired.
- 4. Place all "R" pieces back in original positions. Raise the Eagle, or Lower the lighter stained (R) pieces about 1/8" for a shadow look. Glue together, glue to backer, and finish as desired.
