## WP-706 DUCK AND CATTAILS SILHOUETTE PATTERN by OTB Patterns.

There are many ways to complete this project. Here are a few ideas to get you started

This design is delicate and must be handled carefully. A spiral blade will minimize turning the project.

- 1. Start with 2 pieces of material about 8 1/2" wide x 10 1/2" high
- 2. Cut the pattern from one piece. Trim all cuts with razor knife and sand with 150 grit sandpaper. Stain or paint as desired.
- Hot glue contrasting felt to uncut piece, then glue the scene to the felt. Add metal hanger to back.
  OR- -

-OR- - Cut the pattern from one piece of solid hardwood about 8 1/2" wide  $\times$  10 1/2" high (glue for width as required.) Cut a simple stand from 2  $\times$  2, 8 1/2" long. Cut 1/4" wide  $\times$  y 1/4" deep groove down the center to hold the scene.

- 1 Start with one piece of material about 8 1/2" wide by at least 12" (or 14") high.
- 2. Prior to cutting out the pattern, visit our website free fronts page: http://otbpatterns.com/free.php and download one of our free text fonts. Load the font onto your computer, and type out your name, or create a welcome sign by typing out your text with your word processor using a font size that fits the design. Tape, or glue the printed page to the bottom of your pattern. Be sure to use a piece of lumber long enough to cut your entire revised pattern. Drill holes near top for mounting, or adding chain. Be sure to seal your finished item if it is to hang outside.
