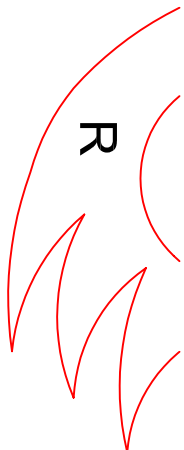

# WP-731 GRIZZLY SILHOUETTE PATTERN by OTB.

There are many ways to complete this project. This is one of our easier patterns to complete. Following are a few ideas to get you started.

1. Start with 1 piece of material about 10" square.
  2. Glue your pattern to your stock. Drill 1/16" pilot holes at all places marked "R" to pass blade through stock. Cut with spiral blade for best control. Note: Some shapes are fragile, and need to be cut carefully.
  3. Attach metal hanger to back, or cut a simple stand from 2x2 or 2x4 stock, 10" long. Cut a 1/4" wide by 1/4" deep groove down the center to hold the scene.
- Another way to complete this project is to:
1. Carefully cut all pieces marked "R" out of your 10" square stock.
  2. Stain or paint as desired.
  3. Place all "R" pieces back in original positions. Raise the outline 1/8" for shadow look, and glue.
