

OLD TIME DOVE WING SPUR STRAPS

Recommended material: 6 to 8 oz. leather.

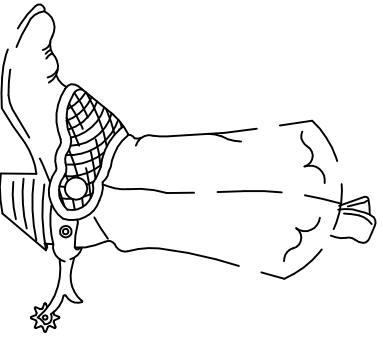
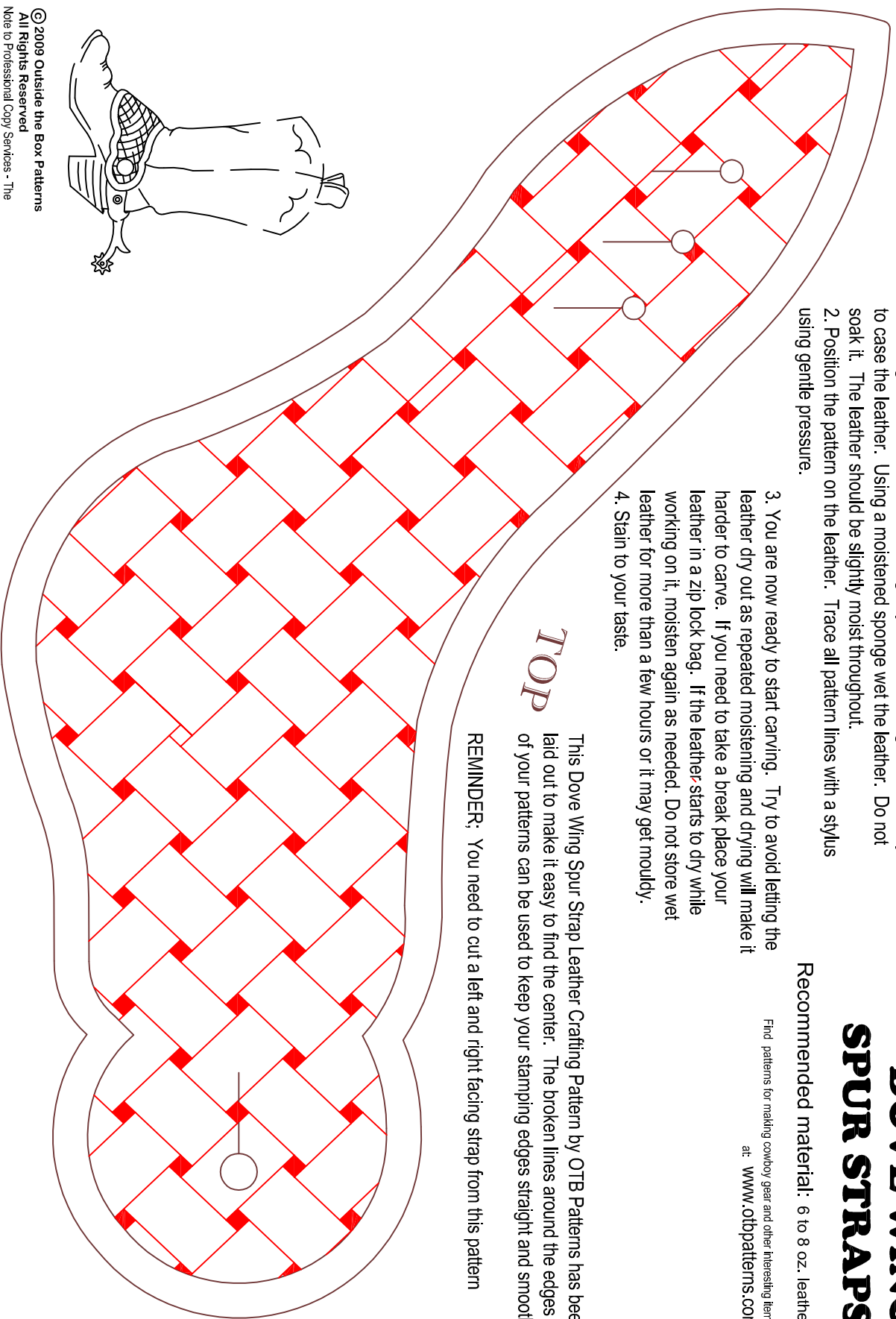
Simple Instructions:

1. Casing the leather. Before starting any leather working it is necessary to case the leather. Using a moistened sponge wet the leather. Do not soak it. The leather should be slightly moist throughout.
2. Position the pattern on the leather. Trace all pattern lines with a stylus using gentle pressure.
3. You are now ready to start carving. Try to avoid letting the leather dry out as repeated moistening and drying will make it harder to carve. If you need to take a break place your leather in a zip lock bag. If the leather starts to dry while working on it, moisten again as needed. Do not store wet leather for more than a few hours or it may get mouldy.
4. Stain to your taste.

This Dove Wing Spur Strap Leather Crafting Pattern by OTB Patterns has been laid out to make it easy to find the center. The broken lines around the edges of your patterns can be used to keep your stamping edges straight and smooth.

REMINDER: You need to cut a left and right facing strap from this pattern



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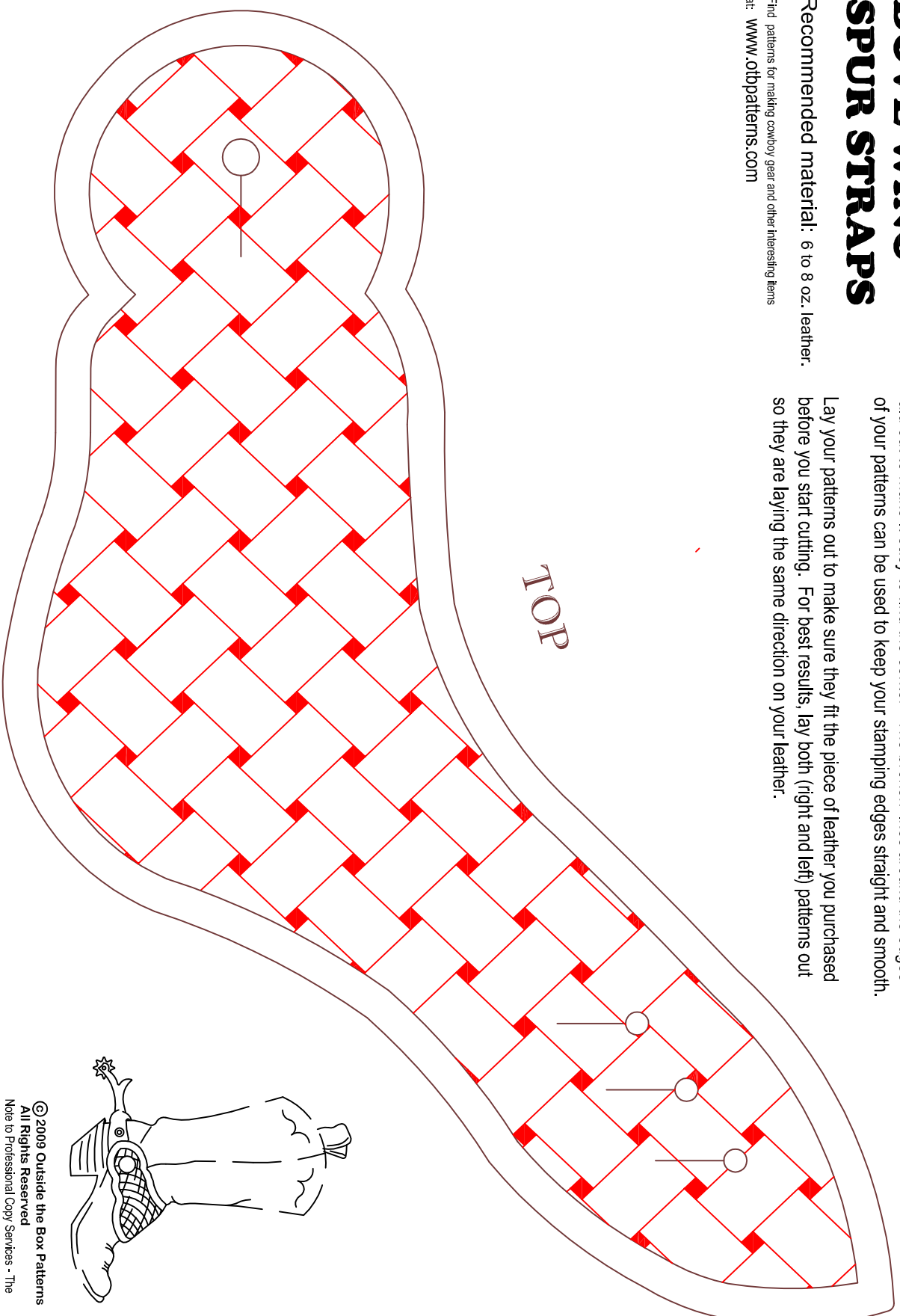
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Lay your patterns out to make sure they fit the piece of leather you purchased before you start cutting. For best results, lay both (right and left) patterns out so they are laying the same direction on your leather.



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
