

This is a fairly simple project that can be used to practice cutting with a scroll saw. When finished, it will be an item anyone can be proud to display.

1. Start with 1 piece of material about 6 5/8" square.

2. Glue the pattern to the material. Drill 1/8" holes near the outside of each interior line and a hole near the edge of the outline to feed scroll saw blade through. Carefully cut, following all lines.

3. Carefully sand all cuts smooth. Use a razor knife to remove any slivers.

4. Stain, or paint as desired.

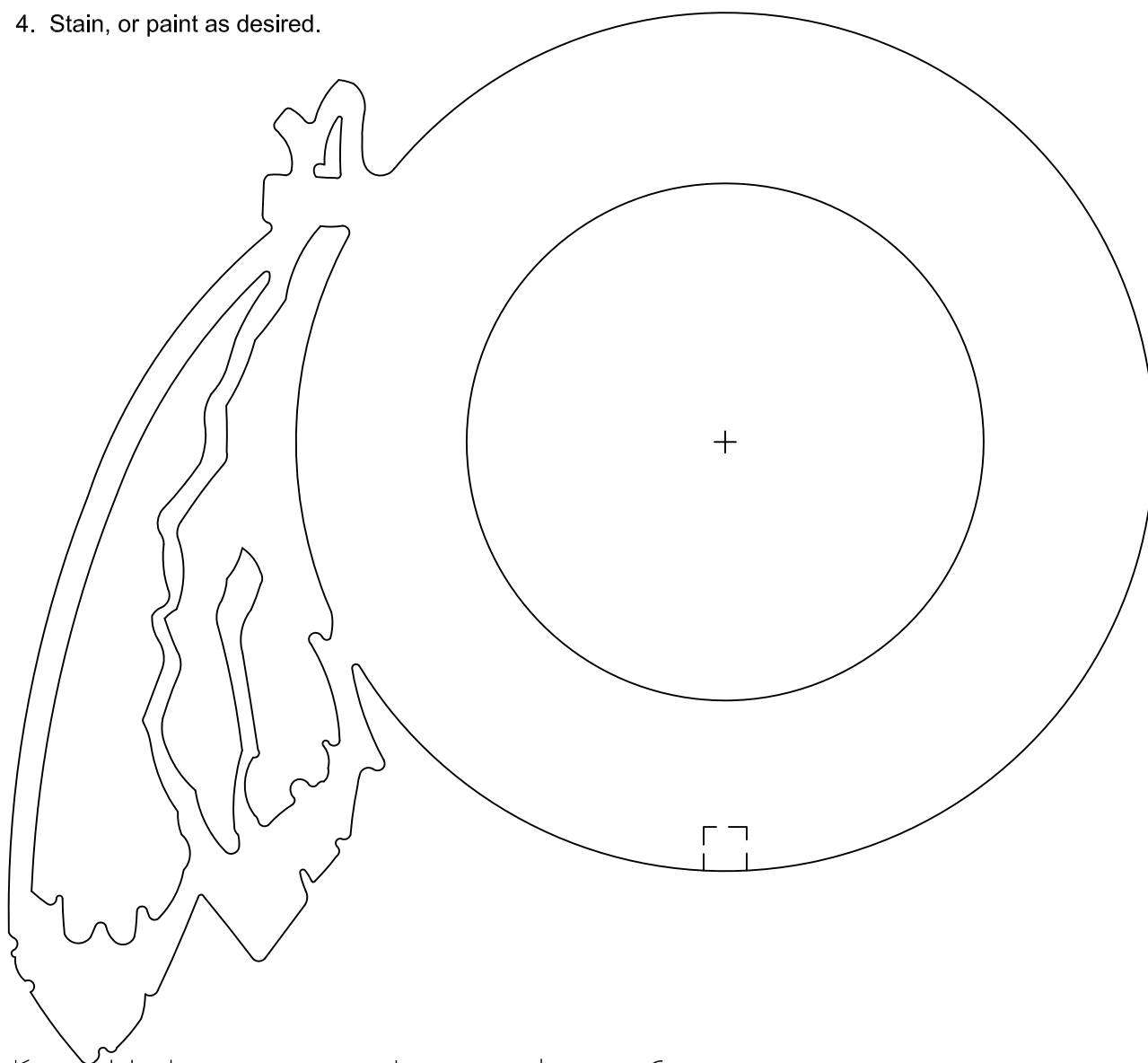


WP-1305 FEATHERS CLOCK PATTERN by OTB PATTERNS.
