



## WP-670 GAZELLE SILHOUETTE PATTERN by OTB.

This is a fairly simply project that can be used to teach a youngster how to safely use a scroll saw. When finished, it will be an item anyone can be proud to display.

1. Start with 2 pieces of material about 6" w. x 12" h.
2. Glue the pattern to one piece of material. Drill a 1/16" hole near the outside of the line to feed scroll saw blade through material. Carefully cut, following the outline. Sand all edges.
3. Leave the second piece as is or cut oval shape. Rout the edge of this piece to give it a more finished look.
4. Stain the back piece, and the Gazelle with contrasting stains, or paint as desired.
5. Attach the Gazelle to the back piece. Finish with clear sealer.
