

WP-701 Angelfish pattern by OTB Patterns

This is a simple pattern suitable for learning or practice.

Cut out each individual piece, stain, and glue to contrasting stained rectangular or elliptical backer. (Use Pattern for placement of pieces.)

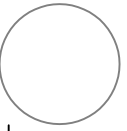
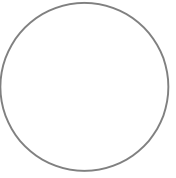
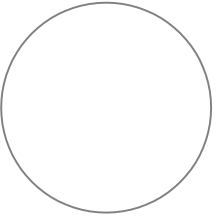
Cut individual pieces from a pre-stained rectangular or elliptical piece of material, and glue to contrasting rectangular backer.

Cut all pieces from one piece of material, cut pieces out of a contrasting piece of material. Carefully round the edges of all the loose pieces.

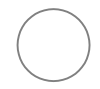
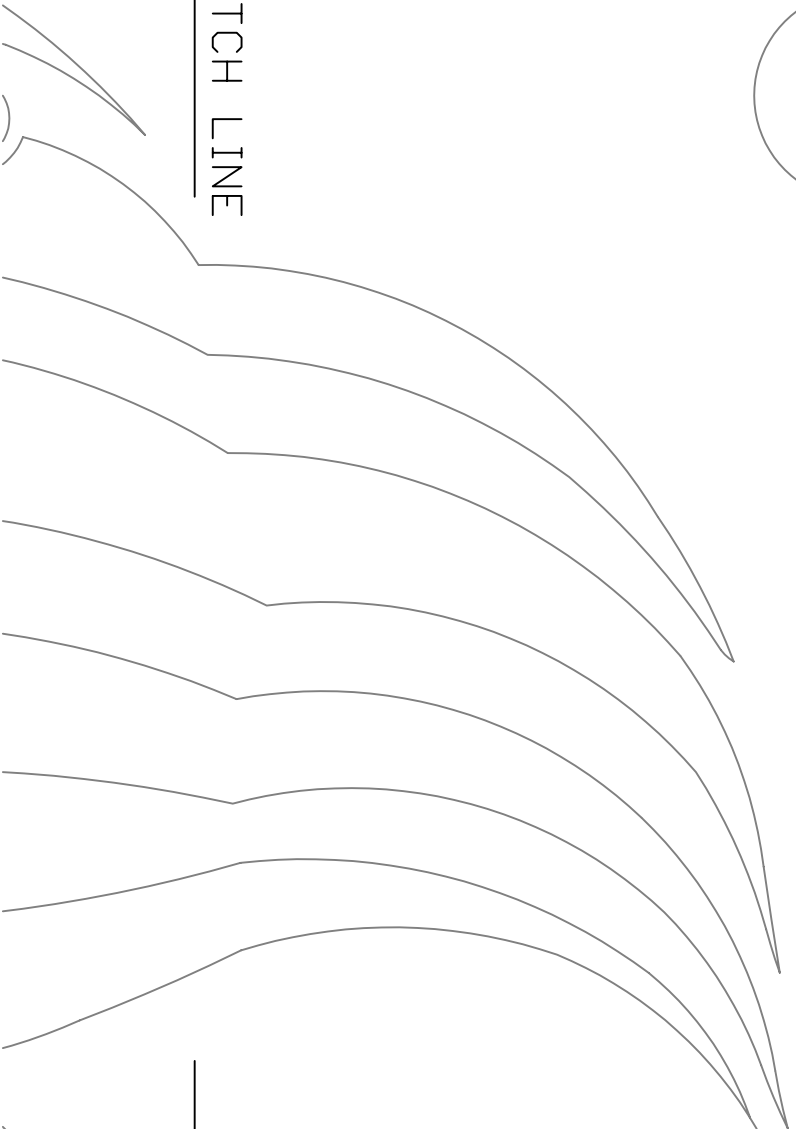
Place matchsticks into holes, and place the pieces cut from the first material into the holes and glue. This will give your finished item a raised look. Or leave the pieces loose to create a simple puzzle for your kids, or grandkids.

Trim all cuts with razor knife and sand with 150 grit sandpaper.

Add metal hanger to back.

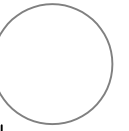

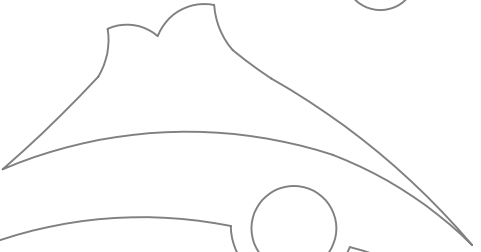
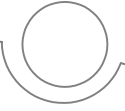
