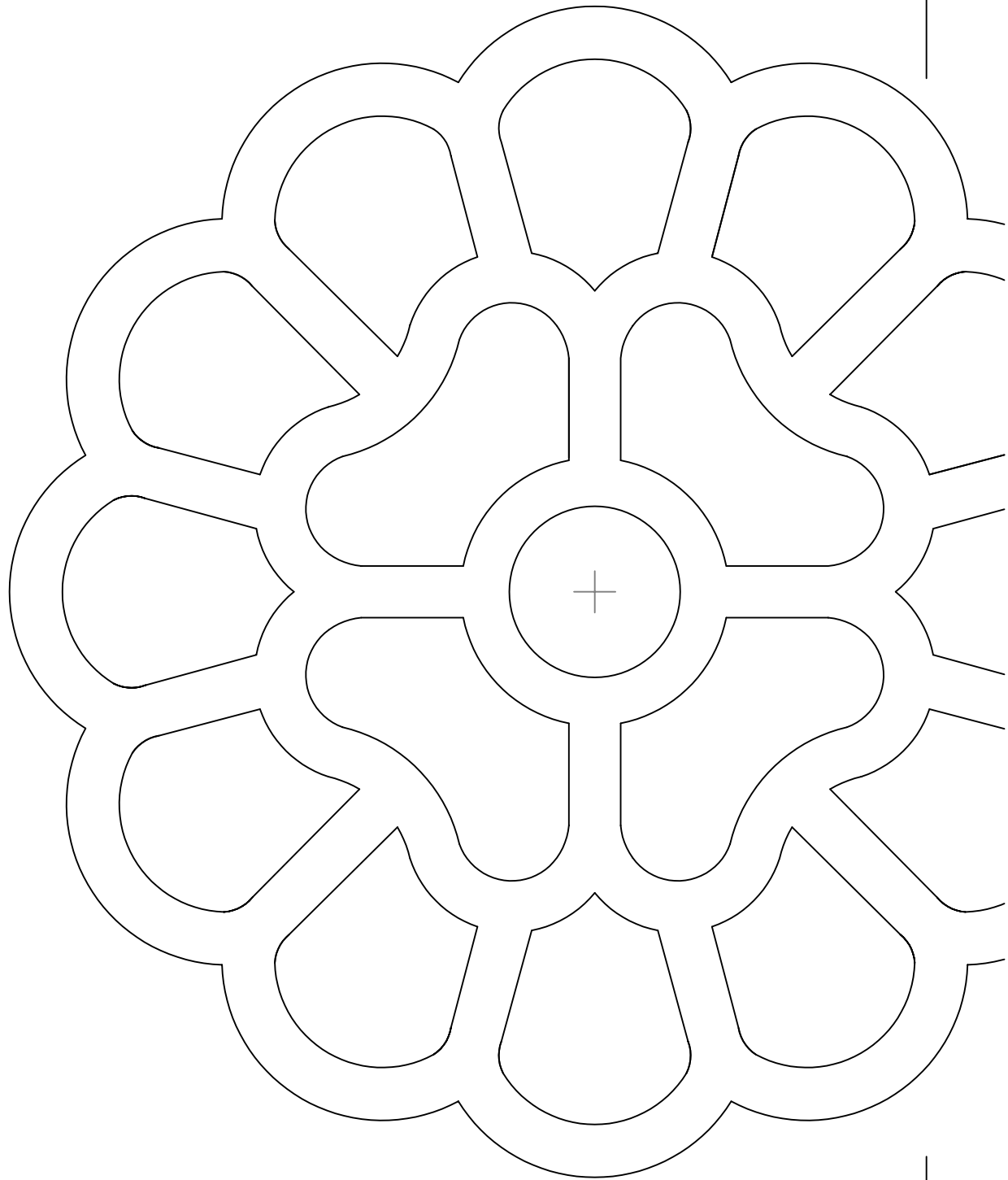


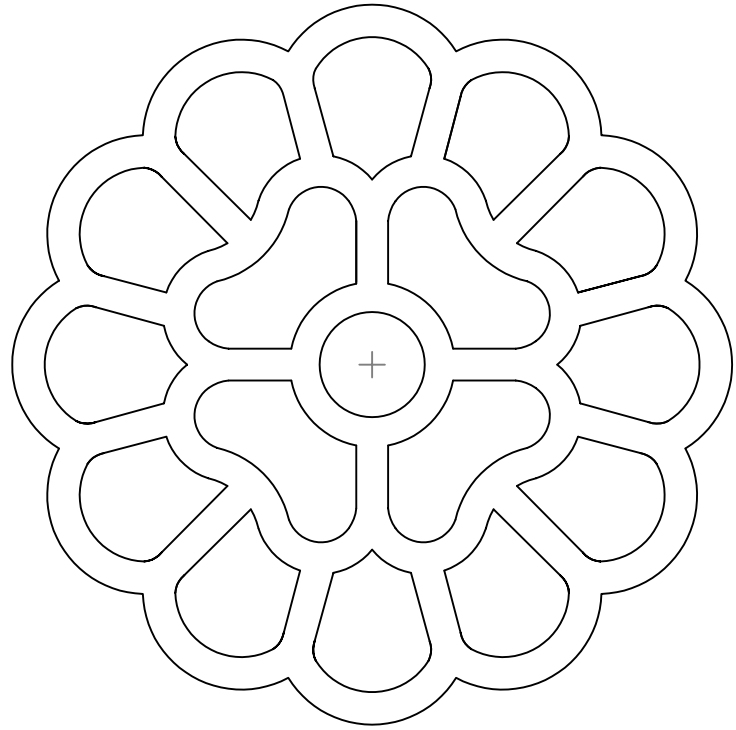
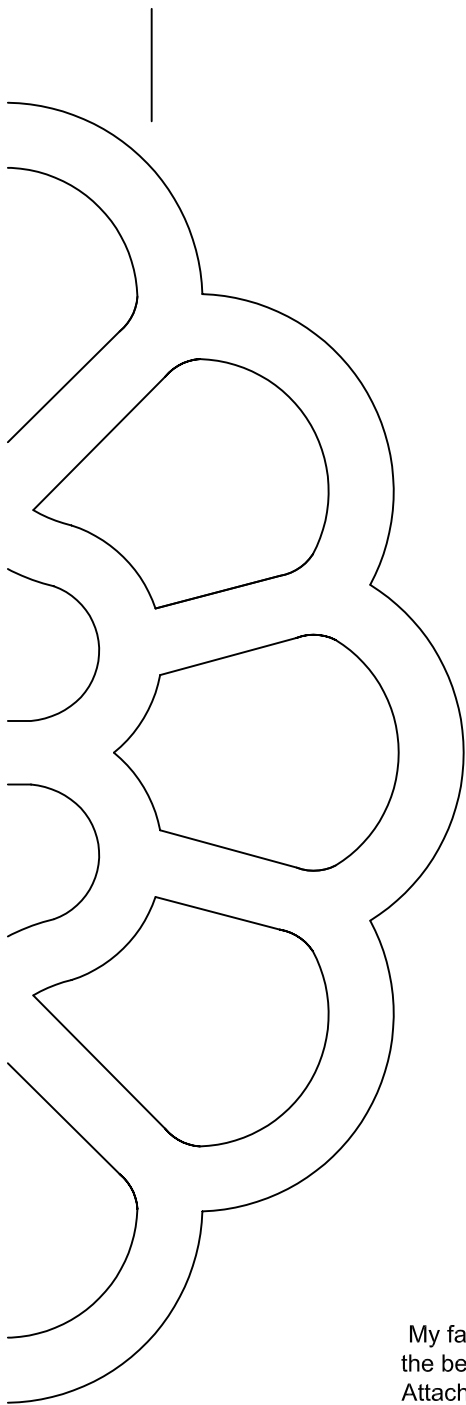

My favorite material to use with these patterns is Western Red Cedar. Many times the best variety of colors can be found in the fence picket pile at your lumber yard. Attach the various pieces of your pattern to your WRC material taking advantage of the color gradations in the wood to give your finished items unique character.

There are several different ways to complete the trivets and coasters. You may cut the trivets out using just the upper pattern using 1/4" or thicker material, or if you wish to use thinner material, also cut the bottom patterns to glue to your upper pattern.

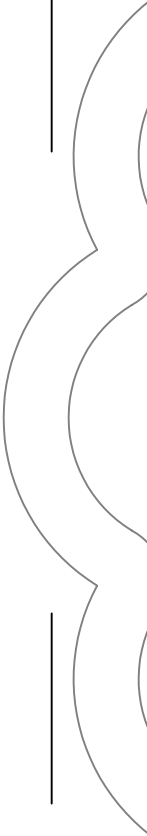
If several of the same pattern trivets and coasters are required, stack and clamp your material so they can all be cut at once. Depending on the final thickness, the material may be screwed or nailed together to help hold everything steady for cutting.

Carefully drill a 1/16" or 1/8" pilot hole to put your scroll saw blade through for all interior cut-outs. Cut the exterior surface of the pattern after all interior cut have been made. Use a razor knife to trim all rough spots, and carefully sand all surfaces. Trivets and coasters may be left natural, or add a finish sealer. (Verify heat will not affect your sealer before using.)
