- 1. Start with 1 piece of material about 8 1/2" square.
- 2. Glue the pattern to one piece of material and use a 1/16" bit to drill pilot hole at each letter.
- 3. Run scroll saw blade though each hole and carefully cut the area out following the outline. Cut out the smaller outer shape last. Sand all edges.
- 4. Cut out the larger outer shape, and sand all edges.
- 5. Paint or stain the two pieces contrasting colors.
- 6. Glue the two pieces together. Finish with clear sealer. Attach a sawtooth or similar hanger to the back.
