


- Once all the interior cuts have been made, carefully cut the outside outline of the candy cane.
- 4. Trim all cuts with a razor knife and sand with 150 grit sandpaper.
- 5. Finish the candy cane with stain, or paint as desired. Tie a ribbon through an opening for hanging on the wall.

You may also cut out a piece of birch ply, or use a log slice as a backer (purchased at your local hobby shop, or sliced yourself). Stain a contrasting color, and attach your candy cane to the front, and a metal wall hanger to the back.
